Project #384: Window Collage!

- Gather some outdoor nature items.
- Gather some magazine or calendar pictures of various types. Landscapes and nature could be nice for this project.
- Purchase some waxed paper in a role and purchase some see through sticky shelving paper (dollar store)
- Lay your items carefully onto the sticky paper as you would like your design to look. (they will be stuck so can't remove them)
- If you like, you can also add some coloured bits of paper or confetti to this or maybe some other small textured items. Sand, Soil
- Place some see through wax paper onto this to complete the cover. You may be able to use see through plastic wrap as well?
- Trim the edges in any fashion you like.
- The edges could be wavy, zig zag, straight etc.
- The shape of your collage could be various too such as a heart, square, circle, rectangle or any shape you like.
- If using the standard shapes, use this as a teaching tool for the children to discuss the names of the shapes.
- If you added any colours into your collage, talk about colours too!

Activity: Nature walk to collect.

Prior to activity, go and collect what you need. Lay the items onto a board or plate and discuss what you have and the textures, colours etc. of the items.
