Project #393: Masks!

(Project by South Vancouver Family Place)

- Create a mask shape. This could be any shape you like such as a geometric shape or traditional mask shape to go around eyes.
- Trace this and cut it out.
- Cut two holes for the eyes (measure the distance between the eyes for a good fit).
- Tape a popsicle stick or larger tongue depressor stick to the back of the mask (off to the side as this will be the handle to hold)
- Use construction paper of various colours to form some leaves. Cut slits into this to give the leaf some shape and depth.
- You may also use clean package feathers. (dollar store)
- The paper feathers can easily be glued on with a glue stick.
- The real feather types will need a stronger liquid non toxic white glue and let dry or you may be able to tape the real feathers on...
- You can also decorate the mask by using felt markers, crayons, pencils etc.
- Finally you may like to add some sparkle glue!

Activities:

If you make geometric shaped masks, talk about the shapes & colours.

Make a puppet show with your various masks.

Play "I Spy" with your masks to make the game a little more fun.

Do a search for items with your masks.
