Ann's Creative Corner Project #399: Faces!

- Let's draw or form our Special Faces!
- Using a template or some shapes, create your facial structure.
- Add details with your Felt Markers, or crayons
- Add some wool or string for hair.
- Try using a profile of your head/face on a side view to see the structure of your nose. This is a silhouette of your face. Stand by a plain wall by a lamp and you will see your shadow.
- An adult can then trace your shadow on a piece of paper taped to the wall. This is really nice for a keepsake as your child grows and changes!
- Try using a mirror and drawing in your facial details as you see them.
- With younger children and toddlers, you may encourage the eyes, nose and a mouth but it is their creation so just colouring is fine too!

Activity: Play Shadow play with your fingers, hands and arms by going behind a thin sheet under the lamp and forming your fingers and arms into shapes. Try using your whole body as well.
