- Take a premade form or draw and egg shape for a face.
- Also the egg shape could have the extension of the neck.
- Cut out a variety of hair styles and colours of hair from construction paper.
- Glue the hair onto the face in the side view, front view or even back view.
- Add some facial details.
- For an alternative project, use some people shaped figures that you may find in a craft or dollar store.
- Children can add details to this including wool or string for hair and clothing. Use a glue stick or liquid glue will work best for the wool, felt or fabric pieces.
- You may also like to cut out some clothing shapes out of construction paper.

Activity:

Gather together in a circle and note the colour of hair, skin and clothing your friends and family are wearing.
