- Cut out some flower shapes, stems and leaves.
- Cut out a circle for the centre of your flowers.
- Using cupcake paper is another idea for a flower.
- Small coffee filters would also be used.
- Crumple up some tissue paper of various colours.
- Glue the flowers onto a piece of construction paper in anyway the children like.
- Add the stems and the leaves.
- Add some details to the flowers with tissue paper, crayons, felt markers, bingo dabbers etc.
