Project #404: Stepping Stones/Painted Rocks!

- Gather various rocks to paint.
- Try gathering some large flat rocks as well as these could be Stepping stones.
- Use a flat walkway such as the walkway leading to your home or garage.
- Using some non-toxic acrylic paint, paint the rocks and stones various colours.
- Younger children can use large sponge type brushes to make it easier.
- This project will require adult supervision constantly.
- The children should also be wearing old clothing and a paint smock!
- Acrylic paint is washable off the brushes and hands but if it is dried, it will probably not come off clothing!
- Be creative with this as it can be anything from a pet rock type idea with glueing on fur and hair to a plain painted rock!

Activity:

Go for a rock walk. Search for various painted rock as you will often see them in the parks. Look for professional paintings on the concrete walls of some storefronts or park walls.
