Project #409: Sunflowers!

(by South Vancouver Family Place)

- Make a sun shape from yellow construction paper and cut it out.
- Cut a brown circle for the middle of your sunflower
- Cut some stems and leaves for the body of the flower.
- On another piece of construction paper, glue the pieces down to form your sunflower/s
- Add some details to this with crayons or felt markers.
- You may like to add some grass seed to the centre of your flower by glueing it down. This looks like the seeds of the flower.
- Add more details to your paper such as the clouds, sun, trees, grass etc. Children can do this in any way they like. Young toddlers and Preschoolers may do a little or alot. It is their creation!
- Try putting tissue paper on your flower and leaves....
- Try using the felt markers to make "Dots" for the centre of the flower.

Activity:

Plant a sunflower. Go to a garden Centre and buy the seeds. View the plants. Go to the store and buy some sunflower seeds to eat. You may find them in the shell or out of the shell (for younger children) They may be salted or unsalted. Plant the grass seed in a small container!
