Project #410: Easter Chick on a Stick!

(Project by Kids Care Preschool)

- Create the basic shape of a chick out of yellow construction paper.
- Create an egg shape out of white, cream or light brown construction paper.
- Cut the egg in half with jagged edges as it will be "Broken" for the chick to sit in.
- Have the children glue the chick onto a Tongue depressor type stick. This may take some time to dry a bit before adding any details. Or you may like to add details such as the eyes etc to the chick first.
- Glue the egg shape to slightly cover the bottom of the chick to make it look like it is hatching.
- Add some feathers if you like.
- Add some googly eyes for those older Preschool Children or sticker eyes for Toddlers.

Activity: Puppet Show!

Children can use Chick on Stick characters as puppets. This is a great way to socialise and practice speech and language. This also encourages friendship and courage to act out things in a puppet fashion.
