## Ann's Creative Corner <br> Project \#411: Easter Headbands and Baskets!

(Project by South Van Family Place)

- Cut a long strip of fairly strong paper that is about 2 inches or 5 cm wide. Make it long enough to wrap around your child's head.
- Cut some bunny shaped ears.
- Staple the ears onto the centre of the headband.
- Children can colour and decorate the ears and the band they way they like.
- Add some stickers if you like.
- Adding some cotton to the ears is another idea.
- For the Easter Baskets, create a box shape from some construction paper or find a small plain box and cover it with paper.
- Add some decorations and stickers to your box shape.
- Cut a strip of paper about 1 in or 2 cm or so for the handle.
- Staple the handle onto the box so it is secure.
- Place some "Easter Grass" into the box. Ready for the Egg Hunt!


## Activity: Go on an Egg Hunt

Place a small chocolate egg into a plastic egg. Seal this with a little tape. If you prefer, place some stickers in the egg instead of chocolate! HIde the eggs indoors or outdoors and begin the egg hunt!
