Project #412: Clouds!

- Cut out some cloud shapes or use a photo copy as shown below.
- Cut out some "rain drops" from scrap paper.
- Have some cotton balls available. It is nice and less waste if you pull the cotton balls to stretch the cotton. This also creates a nice 'flow for the cotton"
- Glue your cut out clouds to another piece of construction paper (blue is nice for the sky)
- Or use your photo copied page.
- Glue the cotton to the clouds.
- Glue the raindrops under the clouds.
- Think of other things you may like to add to your creation like birds or tall trees.....
- Add some scenery to the ground such as trees, houses, pets etc.
- Stickers are okay for some small details but not to replace your HAND DRAWN works as this is your creation! Children are all at different levels of creativity so even a line, dot or any kind of make with a felt or crayon is their work!

Go for a walk and view the clouds. Lay on the grass and watch the clouds change shape.
