### Project #413: Earth Day!

- Cut a circle about 4 inches in diameter in blue construction paper.
- Cut some green or brown land shapes of any continent you would like. Make up the shapes as you like. Be creative and not perfect!
- Glue your circle (the earth) onto a piece of black construction paper if you would like a night scene or blue, green or whatever you choose for a day time scene.
- Add your land onto the circle with your glue stick.
- Draw in any details you would like onto your earth and landforms.
- Use some sparkles for the stars if you like.
- Colour in some details with a felt marker, crayon or pencil to your creation.
- In the sky, you may like to add other planets, the moon or the sun depending on the day or night scene.
- Earth day flowers would also be made by glueing pieces and shapes onto your construction paper.

### Activities:

Go to the Planetarium or Science World if you can. Go for a walk in the day or the evening to view the land and the sky.

Read books on space and earth.
