Project #415: Hands Around the World!

- Create an earth shape.
- Add some land for continents and blue for the water.
- Add as many details as you would like to your earth.
- For younger children you may want to use some stickers of people for example.
- Older children may want to draw land details, houses, people, pets or other features of the earth.
- Trace the child's and cut around it the shape.
- Alternatively, you may want to paint the child's hand for a handprint.
- When dry, cut around it.
- Attach your hands to your earth shape.
- Use a variety of hands of sizes, colours and shapes for your earth.
- If you like, make this into a mobile by attaching a thin string to hang it up.
- Think about other planets you may also like to include in your mobile ideas...
