Project #417: Playdough Tree Flowers!

(by South Van Family Place)

- Using some new or old playdough, place some in a small plastic cup such as a pudding or fruit cup.
- Add some natural branches you may find on the ground outdoors.
- Cut some flower petal shapes and punch holes into the shapes.
- Use a variety of flower shapes and colours.
- After you place the branches in the playdough, children can add the flower shapes by hooking them through the branches.
- Add some playdough to the tips of branches to look like blossoms or pussy willows.
- Another idea for pussy willows is to use small pieces of cotton for the ends of the branches.
- Think of other ways..... Seeds could also be used to drop on the bottom of the creation. Leaves too.... Soil.....

Activity:

Before doing this project, go for a walk outdoors to gather the natural items you may like to use. As you are walking, notice and enjoy the Nature Walk!
