Ann's Creative Corner Project #422: Tissue Paper Flowers!

- Cut some various sized squares of various colours of tissue paper such as the wrapping tissue paper.
- Fold in half and punch a hole into the centre.
- Use 4-5 pieces of tissue paper with the hole in the centre to thread through a pipe cleaner.
- Secure in place by pinching the tissue paper together at base.
- Wrap this securely masking tape, scotch tape or GREEN Masking Tape would be best for the base of the flower.
- The pipe cleaner can be any colour but green is more realistic for the flower.
- Add another pipe cleaner to the stem curl it to form the "Leaves".
- Make a few of these.
- Next lay your bouquet of flowers onto a nice piece of wrapping paper to form the bouquet cover.
- Spray your flowers with some perfume or sprinkle them with talcum powder.

Activity: Garden walk. Go for a walk and look for as many types of flowers as you can find. Smell them and notice the colours and shapes.
