Ann's Creative Corner Project #423: Watermelon!

- Create two circles in green and red (the green one being larger than the red one.
- Create some seed shaped paper out of scraps of paper. These could be brown, beige or black. Create watermelon shaped seeds or it could also be just tiny pieces of paper.
- Glue the red circle into the centre of the green circle.
- Spread more glue onto the red circle and sprinkle it with your homemade seeds.
- Alternatively, you could use real seeds from a watermelon that you have let dry out a bit after enjoying eating the watermelon.
- Another idea is to use felt markers or crayons to Dot your seed shapes onto the red part of your watermelon.
- When you are done decorating and glueing the seeds and colouring what you like, fold it in half. It stands up as a wedge.
- Think of other ways to create this Tissue paper seeds, grass seeds could work as well..... sunflower seeds could work as well.

<u>Activity:</u>

Go to a Farm Market and buy a watermelon. Look at different types of watermelon. Some are very small and some are really big! Eat it fresh. Use some for a smoothie. Maybe add some to your ice cream in a dish. Put in a fruit salad. Use the rind of the watermelon for your compost!
