Project #439: Canada Day Maple Leaf!

- Prepare some maple leaf shaped paper.
- These can also be bought at a dollar Store.
- Some of the maple leaves you can buy could also be a porous type that could be used to blend colours. Or you could put red paint or felt markers on these followed by using a small paint brush with plain water.
- The plain leaves may be coloured by the children with crayons, felt markers, chalk or pastels too!
- When you get a variety of Canada Day leaves, try making a collage!
- Make a Canada Day Leaf mobile by hanging your leaves on a long stick for example.
- Make a Canada Day Tree with your red maple leaves!
- If you are using chalk, draw on the ground with your this.

Activity:

Let's make a Maple Leaf Game! Draw the leaves onto the sidewalk. Play a walking game with music while counting the Maple Leaves. When the music stops, which leaf are you on? Also, look at the maple trees that are in full bloom today. There are many!
