- Fold a piece of construction paper in half crosswise to make a card that opens.
- Clip and fold back the top front of the card to form a shirt collar.
- Children can add details to the shirt as they like.
- Try drawing buttons, zippers, pockets, designs, colours on your Father's Day shirt.
- If you prefer to make a Tshirt shape. Cut the top front of your card in a U or half circle and continue to create a Tshirt look.
- Try some stickers if you like for some details like a pattern on your creation.
- Cut some colourful patterned paper pieces to glue onto your card or shirt or Tshirt!
- On the inside, place some hearts, a verse and To and From or Love From.
