- On a printed and framed type paper, add the note as shown below.
- Glue some tiny footprints onto the bottom and colour them.
- Place this piece of paper onto another to create a framed look.
- Another idea is to paint the bottom of your child's foot if they like this. Some children do not and that's okay!
- Try tracing around your child's foot if they like that.
- Or you may just like to draw feet.
- If you use paint, you could also add some glitter before the paint dries!
- Think of other things such as stickers, drawings etc.

Activity: Colour walk.

Using some flat mats such as the interlocking playmates, make a walking area. Follow the colours with music. When the music stops, what colour are you on! Continue until you name all of the colours!

Outdoors you could also make some squares or other shapes with some sidewalk chalk and use the music and shapes, and colours for your walk as well.
