- Cut out some people's shapes which may be attached such as holding hands!
- Glue these onto a piece of construction paper.
- Children can fill in facial details such as Happy, proud, sad, excited etc.
- Also encourage the children to draw in some details for clothing on the people's shapes.
- Another idea is to cut out various people from magazines or catalogues to make a collage of people.
- Your people may also be placed on a page of scenery such as with houses, buildings, camping, beach etc.
- Use some tissue paper, crepe paper, string wool etc. for your people as this could be hair and clothing.
- Draw in the sky details if they like and the ground details such as trees and flowers.

Song: If you're Happy and you Know it!

If you're happy and you know it clap your hands (repeat 3 times)
If your Happy and you know it, stomp your feet (3 times)
If your happy and you know it, shout hurray (3 times)
If you're happy and you know it, do all three clap, clap, stomp stomp, hurray!

Use various feelings for this chant which could be happy, sad, angry, bored, sleepy etc.
