Ann's Creative Corner Project #429: Rock and Water Painting!

- Gather various sizes and shapes of rocks.
- Wipe clean and let dry.
- Put a paint smock on.
- Using acrylic paint, paint these anyway you like.
- Some children like to mix colours! Thanks Okay!
- Wash the paint off your hands before it is dry if possible.
- Try not to let it dry onto clothing as can be difficult to wash out after it dries!
- Try adding some sparkles to your paint before it dries.
- Water Painting can be as simple as a bucket of water and various sizes of paint brushes.
- Paint the fence, paint the wooden Tables, paint the walls. This is a great activity outdoors.
- Draw with chalk on the wet paint. Blend the colours.

Activity: Collect the Rocks! Water Play!

Count the rocks. Name the colours. What shapes are they? Match the colours....

Play with water play, maybe wash the rocks together.....
