Project #443: Sea Creatures!

- Using a variety of sea creatures, create a mural.
- Cut out and form your own fish, crabs, octopus jellyfish etc.
- Glue these onto a blue piece of poster board or construction paper.
- Add some bubble paper for texture.
- Add some tissue paper for more texture for things such as seaweed.
- Add some tissue paper for shaping the “flowers” in the sea or ocean.
- Add some sand for texture.
- Add “Logs” which could be simple rectangle paper that the children may be able to do the details like the log textures.
- Add the sun and the sky to your mural.
- If you like, add some boats to the water.
- Maybe some birds in the sky.

Activity:

Go to the beach areas and collect items. If you can get some seaweed, dry it out by placing it between some newspapers. Place a book or board on this to flatten it. Check when it is dried. This can also be used in your mural. Get some sand and other items from the beach and add if you like.
