Project #447: Ladybugs!

- Create a body shape by making one large Oval for the body.
- Create a smaller head circle shape for the head of your ladybug.
- Cut another larger Circle for the wings and cut this in half.
- Glue the head to the body.
- Glue the wings on which may be open or closed.
- Try various colours but ladybugs are usually black and red, black and orange or sometimes, black and yellow.
- Add 6 legs if you like as ladybugs are insects with six legs!
- Draw some dots on the wings.
- Draw some eyes on the head part.

Activity: Go on a ladybug search outdoors. You may find ladybugs on trees, in the grass, on flowers, and even on the walls or indoors. Please observe them without touching them as they have delicate legs and wings. Teach the children to look and not touch. Ladybugs will crawl on your hand, legs or arms at times. Just watch them without trying to pick them up.

Song/chant: Ladybug Ladybug

Ladybug ladybug climbing on my toes

Ladybug ladybug climbing on my foot.

Ladybug ladybug climbing on my leg.

Keep singing the chant as the ladybug climbs higher and higher and into your hair! Make the motions and tickle effect!
