- Create a Bus shape out of construction paper.
- Cut out circles for wheels, rectangles for doors and squares for windows.
- Find some shiny paper for the headlights and tail lights.
- Think about cutting a small rectangle for the tailpipe.
- On a piece of paper, the children can glue the bus shape on.
- Next, offer the other pieces in various containers so they see the various shapes. You may want to talk about the shapes and colours and what they are if the children are interested and old enough for the concept of colours and shapes.
- When the children are done glueing their own bus together give the children some felt markers and crayons to draw in more details.
- Let the children decide how to make it and please do not over direct them

Go for a walk and note the Buses and bus stops. Take a ride on a bus.
