

Greetings. My name is Keila. I am a 46 year old woman who arrived in Canada as a landed immigrant more than 15 yrs ago from Nicaragua, Central America. I am a mother to a 8yr old girl and a 4yr old boy. I speak and write fluently in Spanish and English. Canada has welcoming me, my parents and siblings with open arms and so it has become my home. I have worked in diverse jobs and have gone to college to get a career as a health care assistant.

I came across the South Vancouver Family Place by chance when my sister-in-law invited me to meet her there for a play date with my nephew & 3 yr old daughter. First person to greet me was Ingrid Rios and immediately I felt at ease and comfortable and quickly joined in on the drop-in activities for toddlers. A few years later of not coming by my life circumstances changed I had my second child and was having a very difficult time financially, emotionally and was staying home. The pandemic came upon us and made it so difficult to stay afloat and felt like I had to do something reach out to someone as I was more isolated than ever. That someone was again Ingrid she signed me up for the Nobody is Perfect Parenting class in English. This class help me so much in terms of how to self regulate to be able to be present for my children to understand how important self care is and how much of our well being as parent/care giver can affect them. I like it so much that i took it again for a second time in Spanglish with a more Latin American approach in terms of our culture. I wish this was brought back as I believe is important for Latin American mothers to have a safe space to relate and express themselves in these aspects as we are all dealing with generational parenting patterns that may not be healthy but like many we are not even aware of this patterns and/or deep rooted believes.

I thank you humbly for taking the time to read my words and know personally that the work that South Vancouver Family Place does is valued and extremely important. The programs/workshops I have been part of and as you can see it has made a positive impact in my life and my family. I am forever grateful and thankful that Family Place is around to support us in many ways based on our needs. I am on a healing journey and although long overdue I look forward to living a better quality of life.


