Project #457: Back to School!

- Let's make a SchoolHouse
- Cut out your various shapes for your SchoolHouse. These can be squares, rectangles, triangles, circles.
- Glue your pieces onto a piece of construction paper to form your School. Arrange doors, windows, roof etc.
- In the windows of your School, you may like to add some details such as blinds or window partitions.
- Next add some scenery to your project.
- Trees, flowers, Sky, Clouds, Birds, animals such as Squirrels could be added.
- Add grass such as with your crayon, felt markers or possibly some tissue paper or some cut construction paper to form clumps of grass.
- Add children playing by drawing them. These can be as simple as stick people. Remember young children may just draw a head with legs, body or just a head. It is the child's view of people and their level of capabilities. It is their work and is to be valued!
- Add some teachers and other adults.
- Stickers are okay for people as well. They could be people stickers or shapes that details could be added to.

Activity: Go for a Drive or a walk to view various Schools. Play School at home by creating a table with items to work on such as art or workbooks.
