Ann's Creative Corner Project #460: Squirrels!

- Create a Squirrel Shape.
- Children can add details to the squirrel with felt markers, crayon or paint. Tail can be a separate piece to glue on too if you like,
- Add some "fur" by glueing on various shades of browns, beiges, and black wool or string. This is great for the busy tail!
- For the eyes, the children could draw them in or sticker eyes or googly eyes (older children for googly eyes as they can be a choking hazard).
- Place your squirrel or squirrels on another piece of paper to make a 'Scene" if you like. Add leaves and trees.
- Add some nuts to your scene as squirrels like to collect these for the winter.
