## Project #461: Apples!

- Create apple shapes from various colours such as green, red and vellow.
- Create a stem shape and some leaf shapes.
- Create some tree trunks with branches.
- On a piece of construction paper glue on all of your pieces in the way you like. Form your tree, add the leaves, add the apples.
- Some children may like to form a tree, but others may just like to glue on the apples.
- Create a large apple shape that the children may like to glue a stem and leaves on.
- Create a Stuffed apple by cutting out two larger apple shapes from paper. Staple part of this together and then "stuff it" with the scrapes and staple it together.
- Paint your "Stuffed Apple".
- Make apple prints with some plastic or sponge apple shapes and paint.

<u>Felt Story:</u> "Farmer Browns Apples" (use paper or felt apple shapes)

Farmer Brown has 10 red apples hanging on a Tree

10 red apples hanging on a tree

Along came \_\_\_\_\_ (childs name)

And took one and now there are 9!

Continue this until all apples are gone and then count them again.

This is great for interaction with the children as well as counting and naming colours could also be part of this.
