Project #463: Fall Leaf Colours and Collage!

- Let's gather some real Fall Leaves from outdoors.
- Place your leaves in between some newspaper to flatten and spread out.
- Place a book or other heavier paper on top of this.
- Leave this overnight and check the next day to see if your leaves are flat.
- Use these leaves to glue onto another piece of paper with non-toxic liquid white glue.
- Another option is to use some sticky shelf paper and drop your leaves onto the paper in any order they happen to fall.
- Place some clear waxed paper on top of this to "Seal" them in place.
- Trim the edges with pinking shears or other types of scissors.
- Children can also use some small scissors for this. Keep in mind that for the younger children and toddler that small pieces of paper are easier to manage and cut.

Activity: Go for a Fall Leaf Walk. Gather your leaves. Have fun throwing leaves. What do the leaves sound like when you walk on the leaves? Listen, look, smell and feel the leaves and nature on your walk.
