Ann's Creative Corner Project #466: Scarecrow Art!

- Let's create some scarecrow parts from various colours of paper.

 These should be the head, body, pants, shirt, hat, gloves or hands, shoes or feet etc.
- On another piece of paper the children can construct the Scarecrow parts by glueing them onto the paper with a glue stick.
 Glue sticks are easier for the younger children and Toddlers as they are able to place the glue stick onto the paper easily.
- Add details to the scarecrow by colouring or adding some more pieces of coloured paper.
- Add some "Straw" to the Scarecrow picture. This can be part of the scarecrow and/or on the ground or around the scarecrow.
- Add details to the face, hat and clothing.
- Try adding some birds flying around. These can be a simple wavy line or an "m" works.
- Add some sky details if you like.

Chant: "I'm a Little Scarecrow"

I'm a Little Scarecrow packed full of Straw (make packing motions)
Standing up in a big field of fruits. (stand straight)
When the birds go flying, I stand up tall. (stand taller)
Shoo Shoo I say and the birds fly away. (make motions with hands)
