Project #462: Fall Leaves

- Cut out various sizes, shapes and colours of leaves.
- Make a collage of leaves in random order
- Make a scene of trees and other natural vegetation and place smaller leaf shapes in various places such as on the trees and the ground in your scenery creation.
- Add the sky and the clouds.
- Make some larger leaf shapes out of white paper.
- Staple part of these together and stuff with the scraps of paper and then staple this closed.
- Place on the easel or the table and paint this with non-toxic paint.
- You may like to buy some pre-cut leaf shapes and fill in some details like the veins (lines) in the leaf.
- If you have dried leaves, scrunch them up and place the dried pieces onto your creations with some liquid white glue or a glue stick.

Activity: Go Leaf collection and observing the trees and the ground. Talk about evergreen trees and deciduous trees. Talk about what type of leaf they are such as a Maple Leaf. Also the maple leaf is a Canadian symbol.
