Project #471: Halloween Jack O Lanterns!

- Cut out various sizes and shapes of pumpkins.
- Cut out a stem for these according to the sizes you have.
- Children can glue the stem onto the top. The children may put this straight, sideways, upside down but it is their creation so its fine whichever way they like. Older children and older preschool Children may like some guidance and may see this in a typical way but Toddlers may not.
- Add some lines to the pumpkin shape or just add some colours to it.
- Draw eyes, nose, mouth if you like or add some shapes to make the face.
- Tissue paper is another detail you may like.
- Try some sparkles!
- Try some Bingo Dabbers. These can help the children create a face or marks and blemishes on the Jack O Lantern!

Activity: Buy a Pumpkin, Cut, clean out pulp and create a Jack O lantern!

Roast the seeds on a cookie sheet with some salt for about 20 minutes on medium heat in the oven until golden brown. Enjoy eating them when they are cool!
