### Project #473: Spiders!

- Make a large and small circle out of black construction paper.
- Glue them together to form the spider body and head.
- Cut 8 strips of paper for the spider's legs as spiders have 8 legs. These can be straight or have a "Bend" in them as spiders do have shape to their legs.
- Attach the legs to the spider's body.
- Add some more details such as drawing dots for the eyes of the spider. Sticker eyes or googly eyes is also an option. Googly eyes are a choking thing so not for toddlers or babies!
- Tissue paper could be glued onto the body for texture. Scrunch it up and glue onto the spider.
- Other options could be other texture materials such as sand, bits of string, wool, confetti, etc.....
- Make a mobile of spiders by hanging them on a rod or stick.
- Make a spider Web by using some string and glueing it onto paper white non toxic White Liquid Glue!
- Handprint could also be used to create Spiders!
