Project #467: Turkeys!

- Make a turkey shape from brown or beige conduction paper.
- Make some colourful feathers using more construction paper making feather shapes with slits to mimic the feathers or use some store bought feathers in packages.
- Children can glue the feathers on with either White Liquid non toxic glue or a glue stick if the feathers are slim and flat.
- The paper feathers work well with a glue stick.
- Add a sticker eye for the Turkey or a Googly eye (older children as they are a choking hazard)
- Cut out feet shapes, beaks, and facial features.
- Children can construct these by glueing all pieces together.
- For younger children and Toddlers, they may like to be brief with this or it may be easier for them if the Turkey shape is glued onto a larger piece of paper.
