Ann's Creative Corner Project #486: Winter Skates!

- Make a basic Ice Skate shape.
- Punch holes in this for the "Laces"
- Using some Tape or round sticker shapes before punching the holes will strengthen the skate shape.
- Children can decorate or colour their skate/s with various colours and textures of paper.
- Use felt markers, crayons, and paper with a glue stick.
- If the children are interested in lacing the skate/s, you could supply a shoelace to thread in and out of the punched holes. A Shoelace is best as it has the firm tip on it.
- If you use string or wool, be sure to add some tape to secure the threading top.
- Please note that this can be very frustrating to children especially if the threading top is not firm. To avoid frustration, guide the child and be sure to have the right materials.
- The Threading holes must also be firm to thread.
- If the Child or Toddler needs help, please guide them
- A loop or two may be enough for some children. That is fine too.

Activity: Go Ice Skating to skate or even to view the skaters!
