Ann's Creative Corner Project #475: Halloween Crowns!

- Cut some strips of black construction paper about 2 inches wide and use two strips of paper per crown.
- Staple or tape these together.
- When they are flat, the children can use a glue stick and add various halloween shapes such as pumpkins, ghosts, bats, stars, cats or other halloween type stickers or shapes.
- When this is dry, measure this around your children's head and then gently tape it together.
- Some children do not like this being measured or placed on their head. That is fine too.
- Another idea would be to make a crown for one of their toys such as dolls and stuffed animals.
- Use some sparkles on these as well. This can be done before or after they are stapled together if you use liquid sparkles.

Activity: Halloween Party

While having a special occasion, wear your crowns. If the dolls or stuffed animals have crowns, have a little "Tea Party" for them.
