Project #484: Winter Boots!

- Create a boot shape from some construction paper.
- Trace your child's foot for an additional Foot project.
- Colour the boot in any way you like.
- Add some rubber or other textured plastic waterproof type material to the boots.
- Various types of Tape would be good for this project for "Waterproofing" the boot.
- Place the boot shape onto some shelving paper with the sticky back and cut around it. (Cut the shape from the shelving paper before removing the backing)
- If you have traced the child's foot, the children may like to add details to the footprint such as toenails or other details of the foot.
- Try a Foot Print by painting the child's Foot with non toxic paint to make a real footprint! Some children like this and some do not. Do this only if they like it. Have the bucket of soapy water or a cloth ready to wash feet. Nice warm foot bath would be nice for the children.

Activity: Cup Cake Walk!

With many cut out footprint shapes on the floor, play some music. Children can walk along until the music stops! If they are on a certain shape or colour of a foot. They win a cupcake (or other item you may choose)

This could easily be done outdoors with drawing foot shapes with chalk on a boardwalk or pavement area (No Driveways or Roads!)
