### Project #477: Remembrance Day Crafts!

- Create a poppy shape for the flower.
- You may also like to use individual paper petals to glue together to form your poppy.
- Cut some black circles for the Centre.
- Cut a small green circle for the inner part of your black circle if you like.
- Glue these together with a glue stick.
- Add some details with your felt makers such as some lines in the poppy flower.
- Add some red tissue paper for a 3D look is another idea.
- Try using some felt materials to create a poppy.
- These could be glued together with White Liquid Glue or a Glue Gun (Glue guns are very hot so not for toddler, Preschool age or young children)
- If you have a Felt poppy, the children may like to use fabric paint.
