Project #489: Christmas Bells!

- Create a Bell Shape from various colours and sizes of construction paper.
- Add some tape to the top and then punch two holes into the taped part with a hole puncher.
- Thread some string, wool or ribbon through the hole and tie into a bow.
- Children can help with the threading of the ribbon too! A shoelace works very well for this as it has threading edging!
- Use various types of paper shapes to decorate your bell.
- Add some sparkles or shiny paper.
- Add a circle or piece of fabric or cotton to the bottom for the "Bell"
- Make some see through bells from Waxed paper. Place tissue paper in between two pieces of waxed paper.
- An Adult can then place this onto some newspaper and place a light cloth over it. Iron this until the waxed paper is stuck enclosing the tissue paper.
- Trim it as your like. Zig Zag scissors are nice for this!
