Project #491: Christmas Stockings

- Create a stocking shape.
- Make some Christmas and decorative shapes to place onto Stocking
- Have some cotton or wool available for the upper sticking.
- Glitter glue is also a nice touch.
- Felt markers, crayons and pastels should be provided as well
- Children can use liquid white glue if you are using some wool to glue onto the stocking shape as it will stick better.
- Glue sticks are fine for other items such as cotton on the top and other shapes.
- **Be sure the children put the glue onto the stocking rather than the glue on items especially the cotton or wool!**
- Stickers are okay for this project as well but not as creative as the child's own ideas.
- Trying sprinkling some glitter on the stocking when it is done.
- You may also like to place two stocking shapes together as a 3D project! These can be stapled together. Pinch holes in the edges with a hole puncher.
- Thread the wool or string through these to make a nice trim.

Activity: Hang your stockings on a branch or a stick and display on the wall. Hang a sock with your paper stockings. Place some Christmas items into both types of stockings!
