## **Project #493: Candy Canes!**

- Provide some candy cane shapes to make your Art Project!
- If you make some cardboard or poster board candy cane shapes, you could cover them with non-toxic liquid white glue. Then place some pipe cleaner pieces onto this and let dry completely before picking them up.
- For construction paper candy canes, please use the scraps of paper for the red and white lines. Some children may like green lines as well.
- Try other colours too if you like.
- Have some real candy canes on display to look at. Be sure they are still covered in protective paper while viewing them.
- Samples of various candy cane art could also be provided.
- Make shapes from your candy cane shapes. They can form a Heart for example.
- Making candy canes simply out of twisting pipe cleaners together and shaped like a cane is another idea.

<u>Activity:</u> If you make 3D candy canes from pipe cleaners, these make great decorations for your Christmas tree or just hang them anywhere such as door knobs. Remember to taste a real candy cane!
