Project #502: Snowflakes!

- Fold white paper in half and then half again.
- Coffee filters are great for this project!
- Snip pieces out of the edges of the paper in various shapes and sizes.
- When you are done snipping, open the paper and see what design you have created.
- Another option is to use a round shaped paper to fold to create round snowflakes.
- Try different shapes of paper.
- After it is open, you may like to add tiny pieces of cotton.
- Try adding some sparkles with some spots of glue on your snowflake. Liquid white glue works well for this as you may be able to just "Drop" it on so your snowflake does not rip.
- Try different types of paper such as Wallpaper as it is strong! It is nice to have various colours for your snowflake in this case.
