- Use a ruler to create your pier.
- Add some scenery in the background.
- Add some water like the river around and under the pier.
- Try to draw some wildlife like the pigeons you see around the pier.
- Add some Seagulls.
- Add some birds in the sky just by making simple "m" shapes.
- Add some clouds.
- Add rain or sun whichever you like.
- Try finding some pictures in magazines to cut out and add to your scene. Simply cut around the basic shapes of the birds with little details. Adults may help with this for the younger children and Toddlers.
- Stickers are also okay for this project.
- Add duck in the river.
- Marsh grass in the river.
