## Ann's Creative Corner Project #506: Wild Bird Nests!

- Create a nest using some grass, fine sticks, feathers etc by placing them onto your construction paper.
- Use some white glue to glue these down.
- Another idea would be to use some play dough to create your nest. Stick the items into the playdough to form a bowl shaped nest.
- Add some round or oval pieces of playdough for the eggs.
- Find some photos, pictures of wild birds and their nests for a collage!
- If you make a collage of pictures, you may also like to glue on some natural features from outdoors.
- Add some birds or Stickers for younger children to sit on the nest.
- Have fun with whatever you create. No rules just be creative!
- Crows often leave their nest in the trees and will use it again next time as in the photo attached!

<u>Activity</u>: Walk and do Bird Watching and nest searching. Great to look into the trees in the winter where you may see the empty nests! Listen to the sounds of nature. You may hear the ducks and other birds. There are many river bird sounds.
