Project #498: Igloo Art!

- Create an igloo shape such.
- Cut out an arched doorway.
- Draw lines to create "Ice/Snow blocks"
- Provide children with small squares of white paper to glue onto the igloo shape.
- This will make the "Ice and Snow" build of the igloo.
- Next, provide tiny pieces of cotton to glue onto the igloo for more snow. (Cover igloo shape in the glue with a glue stick first and then give the children the cotton pieces)
- Please be sure they do not stick the cotton onto the glue stick as it will block and dry up the glue stick.
- Also Stretch the cotton balls and pull tiny pieces off as this is less waste for the environment. They only need small pieces.
- Place your igloo on another piece of paper if you like to create a scene. Add more details by drawing onto the Scene such as clouds, water, birds, animals etc.
