Project #499: Bears!

- Provide various bear shaped paper.
- Add details as you like.
- Wool, string or cotton balls could also be used for Texture.
- Create a mask with a template of a bear as shown.
- Place the printed bear head on a piece of construction to glue on to make the mask stronger.
- Place on each part of the mask you wish to attach a string to. Punch a hole with a hole puncher.
- Thread a thin string such as some wrapping paper string through this. This should be able to rip at the sides so the children do not have a choking hazard. Adjust as needed by tying it at the back of the child's head.
- Make a scene with various bears.

Chant/Action: Going on a Bear Hunt!

Going on a Bear Hunt But I'm not afraid. (Tap hands on knees)

Look! I see a field, Can't go over it. Can't go under it. So let's go through it swish swish swish with hands.....

Continue with tapping knees to the stream, tree, etc until you get to the CAVE!

When you get into the cave, go slow and excited as you see the nose, fur, teeth etc and then run home following the same path you took!
