Ann's Creative Corner Project #511: Valentines Mobiles!

- Cut out some small hearts.
- Decorate as you like with felt markers,
- Add some sparkle with a glue stick.
- Add some stickers if you like.
- Try some shiny paper hearts too.
- Using a hole puncher, make holes in the top of the hearts
- Attach some pretty colourful thin string or ribbon wrapping twine
- Attach the hearts on the string to a hanger, rod or a stick. Knitting needles are good for this for the older children.
- Place you mobiles on door knobs, on closet hangers, on chairs or wherever you your children think is a nice place for them.
- Hanging them in a window would look nice especially with some light shining on them. Hanging them on a lamp pole is another idea but away from the light bulb for fire safety!

Game: Make some valentines of various colours.

Create a circle of Friends and Family.

Place the valentines in the centre of the Circle.

Take turns with the chant:

Valentines, Valentines: Red, White and Blue I'll find a nice one and give it to you!

Be sure everyone gets turns and all participants receive valentines.
