Ann's Creative Corner Project #512: Valentines Crowns!

- Cut a strip of paper about 2 inches or 5 cm wide and long enough to wrap around a child's head. Poster board is good for this as it is stronger.
- Cut out some small hearts of various sizes, shapes and colours.
- Children can use a glue stick to glue the hearts onto the long strip of paper.
- Add some stickers, sparkles or shiny bits of paper.
- Try using some fine QTips and paint dots or other smaller images on your strip of paper.
- Let it dry.
- Measure around the child's head and secure the "Crown" together with Tape or Staples. Tape for younger children is best.
- Often, children do not like their head to be measured or also may not like to wear the crown. This is fine as it is the process of art and not the product.
- Some children may have interest in just making a strip of Valentines which is fine too.
- Some children may like to try to cut their own heart out too or add bits of various shapes of paper. That's okay too!
