Ann's Creative Corner Project #517: Wiggly Ribbons and Dance!

- Twist a pipe cleaner into a circular shape and twist together.
- Cut some ribbons or reflective type plastic strips of paper into about 2 foot length or 60 Centimetres.
- Tie the ribbon or reflective strips to the circular shaped pipe cleaner. Use as many as you like but 2 or 3 are sufficient.
- The length can vary depending on the age and size of the children.
 Shorter ones are best for toddlers and Preschool age children.
 There will be less tangling of the ribbons and easier to manage if they are shorter.
- Try various colours of ribbons but be sure they are lightweight.
- Another idea would be to use a cylinder such as a paper ring (from old tape rolls and attach your ribbons.
- A paper towel roll with ribbons or strips of paper will also be nice for this.
- Try tying some ribbons together and then attaching a clip to them could also work.
- Ideas for this are endless but keep in mind that this project must be safe, non toxic and non choking items.
- Ribbons, plastic, string, wool must be supervised at all times to avoid children choking or tangling in them.
- Do not use near areas where they may get caught on something as the children could also be caught or fall.

<u>Activities:</u> Dance with your ribbons to the music you choose. Wave your ribbons. Ribbons may be up and down, side to side, round and round and other movements you may like!
