## Ann's Creative Corner Project #519: Garden of Flowers!

- Cut out various shapes of flowers, petals, leaves and stems from some construction paper or other coloured paper.
- Children may glue these pieces onto another piece of paper in any order they like to create their garden of flowers. Please let children be creative as it is their creation!
- The children may like to add some scenery with felt markers, crayons or other shaped paper.
- Try adding some details with a QTip dipped in paint
- Add some natural items you may find outdoors such as pieces of pressed flowers, leaves, twigs.
- Make some cloud shapes, raindrops, sunshine......
- Add some texture with some tissue paper of various colours.

**Activity**: Go for a nature walk to view any Spring Flowers popping up. You may see the greenery starting and/or flowers too! Use some of these items in your creation or also be sure to rescue those broken stems you may find and place them in water!
