- Maybe there are trees in the background.
- Young children and toddlers may do a little or alot.
- It would be good to have some papers already started for the younger children so that they can add details to it.
- Do this as a Family Project Mural where all Family Members can add details.
- Do this with a group of Friends and share the project ideas!

Activity: Go for a River Walk to get some ideas for your Mural! Have a show and tell with some items you may find along your walk. Show and Tell can help your children to be confident and appreciated. Some children may show and not talk and that is fine too. Encouragement and compliments will always be a positive experience!
